#### HISTORY OF THE AVIATION ORDNANCEMAN RATING

Aviation ratings in the U. S. Navy were first authorized by a Circular Letter of 1 July 1921 with the following aviation rates being established: Aviation Machinist's Mate (AMM), Aviation Rigger (AR), Aviation Metalsmith (AM), Aviation Carpenter's Mate (ACM), and Photographer's Mate (PhoM). Wings were simply added to the existing insignia, however, an airplane propeller was substituted for the ship's screw in AMM (AD now). Prior to 1921, Petty Officers assigned to aviation duties, and aviation qualified, carried an (A) after their rate, ie; MM2c(A) instead of AMM2c. Qualifications for these (A) rates required meeting the standards of the general rating in addition to those required for the aviation specialty. The Aviation Carpenter's Mate and Aviation Rigger rates were abolished just prior to WWII as Naval Aviation had made the transition from wooden biplanes to metal monoplanes.

The rating of Aviation Ordnanceman (AOM) was authorized by Circular Letter of 2 March 1926. Most of the pioneer Aviation Ordnancemen were converted Gunner's Mates and were thus entitled to wear their "crow" on the right sleeve. Captain Bill Scarborough and Art Hoffman were Aviation Ordnancemen prior to WWII and both can remember right arm Aviation Ordnancemen. I enlisted in 1943 and cannot remember any right arm AOM - perhaps I was not very observant! For the AOM rate, the Warrant Gunner's insignia (flaming bomb - or whatever??) was adopted - with wings added.

Abbreviation for AOM was changed to AO by C/L 106-40 of 9 June 1948. Am I old? - there is a whole generation of AOs (many now retired) who were never AOM!! Chiefs were designated ACOM - Aviation Chief Ordnanceman, instead of the present AOC.
